

# **Making Your Doctoral Dissertation Available Online**

Making your doctoral dissertation available online is a duty stated in the Rules of Degrees (FY 2013 Ordinance of MEXT item (v), April 1, 2013). All degree recipients must make their doctoral dissertations available on the internet, unless they have inevitable reasons.

At University of Tsukuba, doctoral dissertation are made public on **University of Tsukuba Repository (Tulips-R)**, an online database for academic information. Please be very careful so that you will not violate the rights of yourself as the author and other co-authors by publishing your doctoral dissertation on the internet.

## ■ What's the Tulips-R?

Tulips-R is a database for making University of Tsukuba's research and education results public on the internet.

By registering your doctoral dissertation on Tulips-R,

- Your doctoral dissertation will be available to the whole world for free via the internet
- ♦ The University of Tsukuba Library will manage and permanently archive your doctoral dissertation data
- The National Diet Library will automatically collect and permanently archive your doctoral dissertation data
- ♦ Each doctoral dissertation (main body) will be given a DOI\*
- \* DOI (digital object identifier): an identifier given to academic articles that guarantees permanent access on the internet. Papers with DOI are easy to cite and are more likely to be cited.

# Points to be checked

#### 1. Things to Note When Writing

- a. If quoting from other works: did you follow the fair use rules of the copyright law?
- b. Make sure you are not violating portrait rights.
- c. Make sure personal information etc. that are inappropriate to publish on the internet is not included.
- d. You do not intend to apply for a patent with the doctoral dissertation.
  - \* Since research results published on the internet etc. lose novelty, you basically cannot apply for a patent after publication.

# 2. Confirm Whether You Have Permissions from the Copyright Holders



- a. If the doctoral dissertation has already been published in academic journals etc.: have you obtained permission from the publisher on publishing the doctoral dissertation on Tulips-R?
- b. If you are planning to submit the doctoral dissertation to academic journals etc., or publish as a book: have you obtained permission from the publisher on publishing the doctoral dissertation on Tulips-R?
- c. If you have co-authors: have you obtained permission from your co-authors on publishing the doctoral dissertation on Tulips-R?

#### 3. Check the PDF Format

- a. Have you embedded the fonts?
- b. Have you removed access restrictions such as **encryption**, **passwords**, and **print restriction**?
  - \* PDF format PDF/A (ISO 19005) is recommended.

## 4. Final Check Before Submitting

- a. Do you have the "main body" of the doctoral dissertation on the CD-ROM?
- b. Do you have a title page containing the doctoral dissertation title and the author's name for the first page?
- c. If the doctoral dissertation will not be made public: do you have the data for the "main body" and "abstract" of the doctoral dissertation on the CD-ROM? Have you checked for typographical errors on the abstract file?
- d. Do you have the "Request for Non-disclosure / Disclosure on the Internet of My Dissertation" ready?

#### 5. Others

a. Make sure your doctoral dissertation meets other specifications of the research faculty/Academic Service Office.
